

## **SECTION 2 PROTEST PROCEDURE**

*Only decisions involving misinterpretations and misapplications of a rule may be protested.*  
**(NO PROTEST IS ALLOWED IN MATTERS INVOLVING SOLELY THE OFFICIALS JUDGEMENT)**

### **SECTION 2 PROTEST PROCEDURE**

1. *The protest must be announced to the officials on the first dead ball after the situation occurs and before play is resumed.*
2. *The exact protest must be described in writing by the individual making the protest before the game is allowed to continue. The written description must include:*
  - A. *The rule in question and how it was misinterpreted.*
  - B. *The score.*
  - C. *The time in the game.*
  - D. *The number of fouls per player.*
  - E. *The number of timeouts per team.*
  - F. *The players in the game.*
  - G. *Any other relevant information.*
  - H. *The protest must be signed by both officials and both coaches.*
3. *Finish playing the game.*
4. *Notify the Section 2 Girls' Basketball Chairman (Pete Bly at 639-8686) that evening if possible, but no later than 7:00 a.m. the following morning.*
5. *The Section 2 Girls' Basketball Chairman will then contact the opposing coach and the two officials involved in the protest.*
6. *After all the facts are gathered, the Section 2 Girls' Basketball Chairman will notify the Protest Committee and the President of the CDBWBO or the Mohawk Board, whereupon a decision will be made.*
7. **THIS DECISION IS FINAL AND CAN NOT BE APPEALED.**
