Due to the length of afterschool hours, when trading or playing has concluded, homework may be started.

If you are interested in joining, have your parents read this letter and completely fill out the attached form. Hang this top part in a place (at home) that you and your parents will see frequently. Return the bottom part to me by October 4th. Please make sure that ALL parts are completed.

SPECIAL QUFSD NOTE TO PARENTS: If a parental ride has been circled below, and that ride is not present at the end of the session, your child will be sent home on the activity bus. This is a district-wide afterschool activity policy. No exceptions will be made, unless you have personally contacted the WHBI staff and made them aware of any issues.
